Sermon: "Warning!", Pt. 2 from Mark 13 Doxology



This week our readings cycle through those Psalms (52-60), most of which were written by David in days of desperation. In these Psalms we experience a kind of harshness in language not typically associated with the language of prayer. David describes his attackers with startling vividness: 'venomous serpents' (58.4); 'howling dogs' (59.6). His experience of struggle has been received by David like 'a land that has been torn open" and 'wine that makes us stagger' (60.2,3).

We ought not recoil from David's language. There is an honest transparency in David's pleadings, expressed as they are from a heart seeking a way forward and trying to make sense of his own direction. Rather we ought to find, at least, some comfort in David's example; perhaps even a way forward ourselves. For David does not hide his predicament from God. David depends upon God in the midst of it.

Our Call to Worship is from Psalm 59.16 & 17.

But I will sing of Your strength;

I will sing aloud of Your steadfast love in the morning. For You have been to me a Fortress

and a Refuge in the day of my distress.

O my Strength, I will sing praises to You,

for You, O God, are my Fortress, the God Who shows me steadfast love.
