



From Our Treasurer

Community Support Activities have Grown

Thanks to the generous support of our congregation, friends and the Nantucket community, St. Paul’s financial position continues to strengthen with steady growth in 2025.

We are expanding our presence on the island to make “God’s love more widely known” through our many outreach ministries. Our endowment and long-term investments continue to grow, and we’ve completed a campaign to preserve our historic church building for years to come.

As we grow, so do our expenses. Our 2026 operating budget is projected to be between \$850,000 and \$900,000, with Stewardship income covering about 65% of this funding. This year, our Stewardship goal increases by 4.5% to \$575,000.

Thank you to all our parishioners and friends—your generosity makes it possible for St. Paul’s to serve the greater Nantucket community.
