SERMONNOTES

Benediction: A Good Word for 2023 • Romans 15:13 (NIV)

The English word benediction has roots in Latin: *bene* (well) + *dicere* (to say) = "to speak well of, to bless." What word of blessing would you place on 2023? Is there a word of blessing that might anchor your faith and practice into 2024?

- 1. Maybe the most well-known benediction is found in Numbers 6:22-27 as Moses blesses Aaron and his sons: *The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make His face to shine up on you and be gracious to you; the Lord lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.* Can you recall a ceremony or worship service when this Aaronic blessing was spoken? How did these words apply to and/or enhance this event?
- 2. Romans 15:13 contains another benediction, this one filled with many of the great words of the Christian faith: *hope, joy, peace, trust, power*. Why does it matter that Paul ends his theological treatise with this "good word" full of "good words"?
- 3. The book of Romans includes much theological treatise. But in Romans 15:13, the human author, Paul, packs a powerful punch with this benediction. Perusing the first part of Romans 15 (verses 1-13) what reason(s) might he have for inserting this "good word" here?
- 4. It's been said that humans can live about 40 days without food, about 3 days without water, about 8 minutes without air, but only for 1 second without hope." Do you agree? What would it be like to live without any hope at all?
- 5. Sketch a picture even if you aren't an artist the God of Hope pouring peace and joy into a life! (If you need a place to begin, think of a pitcher pouring into a glass!)

- 6. Do you think it's possible for someone to *overflow* with peace and/or joy? Defend your answer.
- 7. As we move from 2023 into 2024, to whom could you offer a "good word"? Where might you need to hear a "good word"? How might you receive a "good word" (or the Good Word!) already spoken?
