Amazing Place is a faith-based organization that supports families dealing with dementia and Alzheimer's while promoting brain health for all. It offers a Day Program and Cognitive Stimulation Therapy for adults with mild to moderate dementia or Mild Cognitive Impairment (MCI). For caregivers, there are educational resources, support groups, and counseling. Amazing Place provides free Brain Health classes to educate on dementia, memory preservation, and aging process navigation, as 45% of dementia cases can be prevented through lifestyle changes.

Dan also leads friendship groups in Chicago, gathering Christians, Muslims, and Jews to dialogue on Kingdom life, reconciliation, and the teachings of Jesus.

Boys and Girls Country provides a Christian home for children from families in crisis and ensures their care, welfare, safety, and security. In doing so, they work with each child toward building healthy relationships, acquiring responsibilities, and setting realistic short- and long-term goals. Spiritual formation, family life, education, physical and mental health, and preparation for life beyond high school make up their core services.

Bridges to Life

Bridges To Life connects communities to prisons to reduce the recidivism rate (particularly that of violent crimes), reduce the number of crime victims, and enhance public safety. Their spiritual mission is to minister to victims and offenders to show them the transforming power of God's love and forgiveness.

Missionary Partner: Family Serving in Southeast Asia

MDPC Field Partner Dr. M and his family show God's compassion to the unreached by meeting physical needs through dental health. Dr. M practices and teaches dentistry while sharing the Good News of Jesus with tribes living in abject poverty in Southeast Asia. There, the 98% Muslim population has the least amount of dental care in the world.

They create Gospel centered social media content in Arabic to connect with unreached people in Lebanon and throughout the Arab world that are interested in learning about Christ. Hannah also provides trauma counseling and leads trauma healing Bible studies to minister to women in their region. Pray for Hannah, Mario and their outreach team as they proclaim Christ, engage seekers, and disciple new believers.
