



What is Church in the City?

One of MDPC's Advantage Goals is to serve together in the city one Sunday a year. Outreach is an important part of our life as a church family, and we want to serve our city well for Christ. This will be a day for us to worship God and to serve those whom Christ has called us to serve.

What are the different projects for 2024?

This year we have 7 projects at a combination of locations with shifts on Saturday and Sunday!

Serve at MDPC:

- Make sandwiches for Kids' Meals
- Create and assemble items to support our local ministry partners

Serve Offsite:

- Sort, organize, and pack meals at the Houston Food Bank (535 Portwall St, 77029)
- Work to beautify indoor and outdoor areas for women and children at Santa Maria Hostel (2605 Parker Rd, 77093)
- Paint facilities and stripe lots to support children and families at SpringSpirit (8526 Pittner Rd, 77080)
- Connect with students at Houston Christian University (meet at MDPC; HCU is at 7502 Fondren Rd, 77074)
- Assemble and distribute toilet paper, socks, and cards to clients at Magnificat House (2009 Congress St, 77002)

Serve at Home:

• Write letters of encouragement to our global missionary partners.

What are the age limitations?

Each project has age guidelines in order to insure that projects are meaningful for everyone participating.

Children under 6 years old are invited to participate in Kids' Meals and Partner Projects.

Those over 6 may participate in Houston Food Bank, Santa Maria Hostel, and SpringSpirit projects with a parent.

Ages 16+ may participate at Magnificat House, and adults 18+ at Houston Christian University.

Children under 18 must have a parent with them for all events.
