### Class Cancellations and Refunds

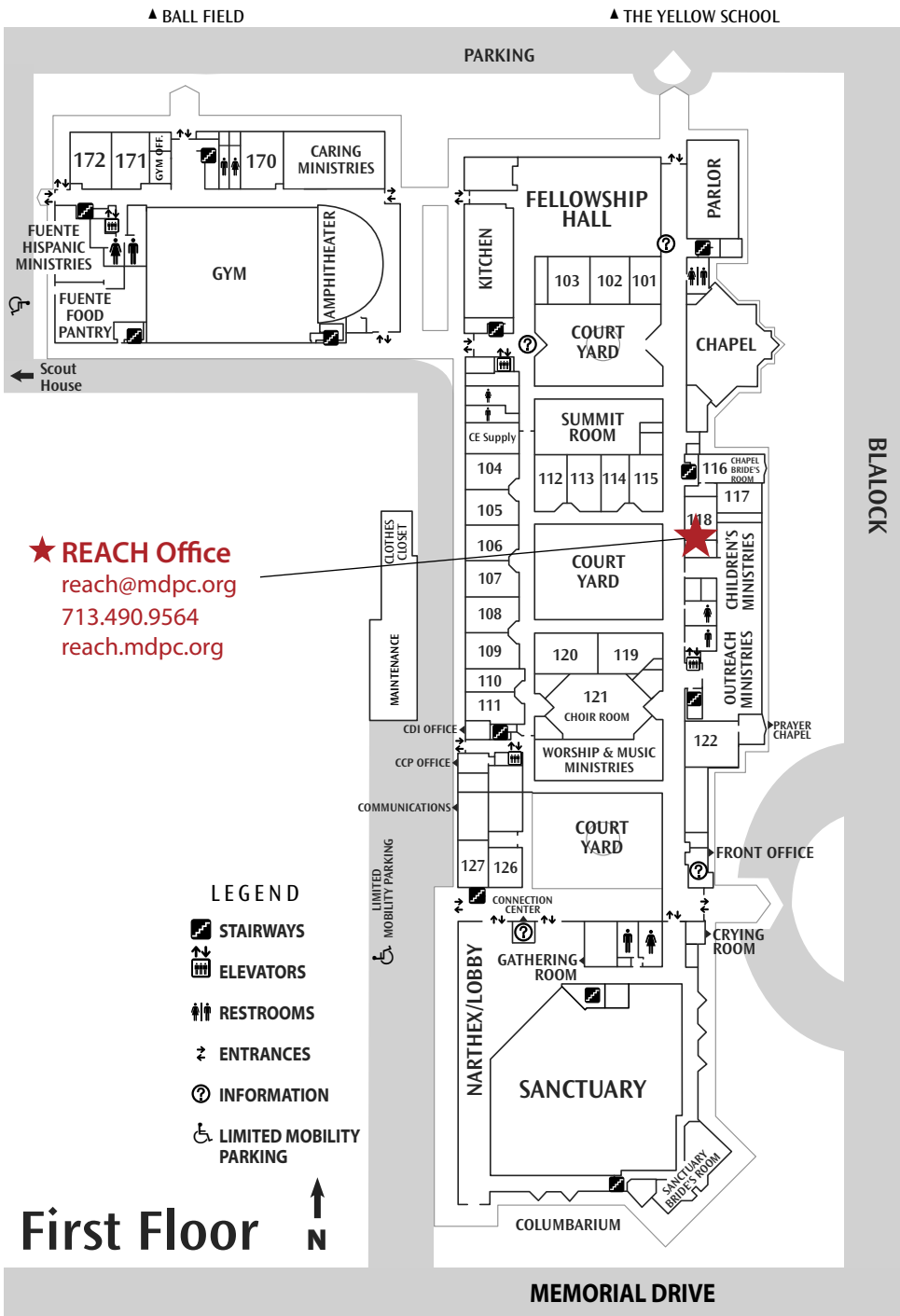

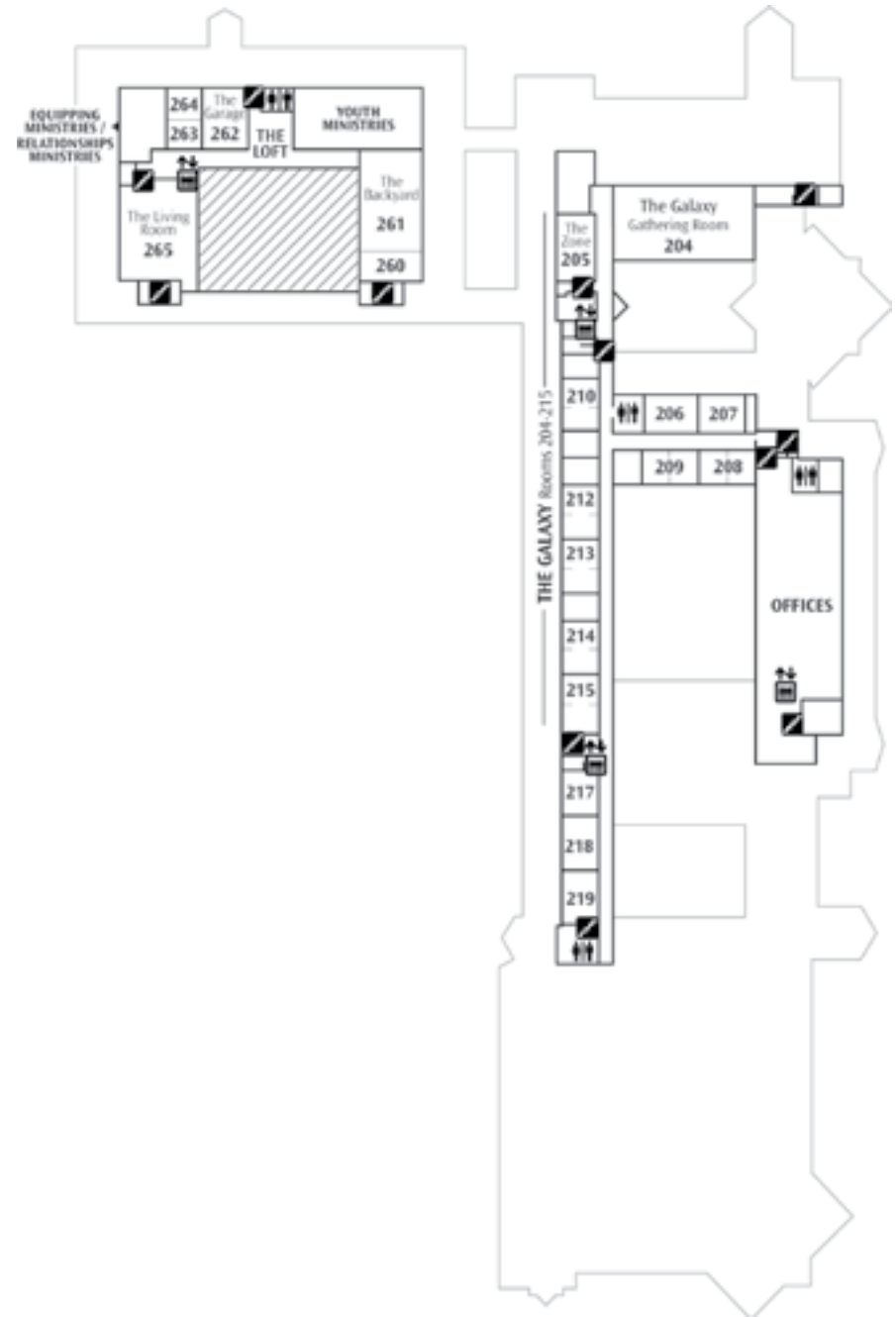

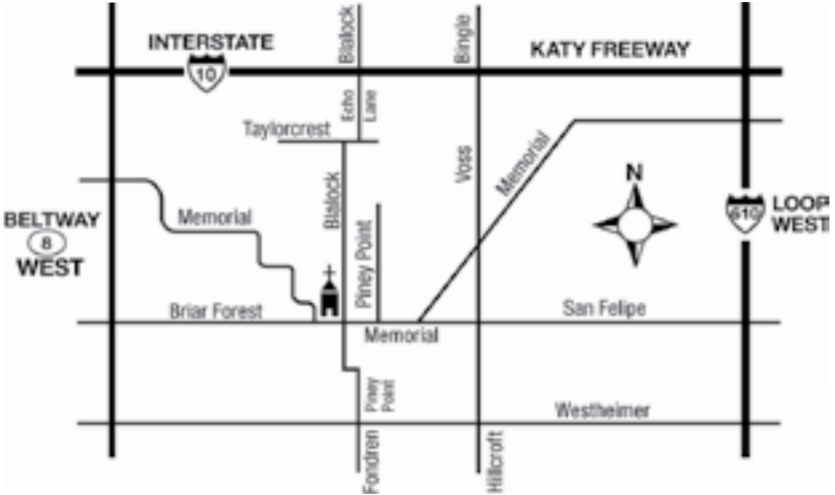
