What is the game?

Friendly Feud is based on the TV game show, Family Feud with a few alterations.

All teams will play at the same time. There are no “face offs” or individual challenges.

Teams write their answers on paper rather than shouting them out.

Is this a trivia game?

This is not trivia. The questions are very general with answers based on public surveys.

Sample Question: Name something people add sugar to.

Sample Answers: Cereal, Coffee, Tea, Fruit

What's a team theme?

An optional but fun addition to the game. A team theme can be something as simple as wearing the same kind of clothing (Husker, Golf, Tanzania) to everyone wearing matching shirts (Southwood Shirts) or you can take it a little further and dress like movie characters, or something that represents your team's personality.

How is best team theme judged?

Everyone at the event has the chance to vote by putting money in the team jars. The jar with the most votes (money) will win. *Bring cash to vote for best team. All votes (money) will go to Missions but the winning team will receive a prize.

What time does everything happen?

The doors will open at 6 PM. Food will be available and the bar will be open. Teams can check-in and socialize until 6:30 PM.

At 6:30 PM the fun begins.

We will finish the game and announce the winners by 9:00 PM. Everyone is welcome to socialize until 10 PM. Last call at the bar will be 9:45 PM.

What kind of food will be offered?

A buffet of appetizers and snacks like sliders, veggie crudite, bruschetta and cookies. There will be gluten free and vegetarian options.

Is this an event for kids?

Older kids are welcome. Little kids would probably not enjoy this event.

Will there be an opportunity to donate to Missions?

This is a fundraiser so of course there will be ways to give. Bring cash if you want to use your donation to vote for best team. Checks and online giving are also options for donating.
