- Support worthy organizations not presently funded by WPC's current annual budget

Ministries account

- Provide support for existing or planned programs as part of or in addition to WPC's ministry work

Building & Facilities account

- Maintain, upgrade or repair WPC property not covered by Capital Reserve funding

WPC Endowment Fund

New Covenant Trust Company

Manages all 3 accounts for Income & Growth

A subsidiary of Presbyterian Foundation

Environment/Social/Governance-based Investment Philosophy

Amount available for annual gifting

4% of Principal (based on 3-year average balance)

- Charitable - \$23,660.
- Ministries - \$8,691.
- Bldg/Facilities - \$7,861.

WPC Endowment Fund

Charitable - 9 grants

- Grant requests received Quarterly (by 10th of Jan/Apr/July/Oct)
- Award decision that same month; grant sponsor notified
- WPC Endowment check prepared and presented at photo opportunity

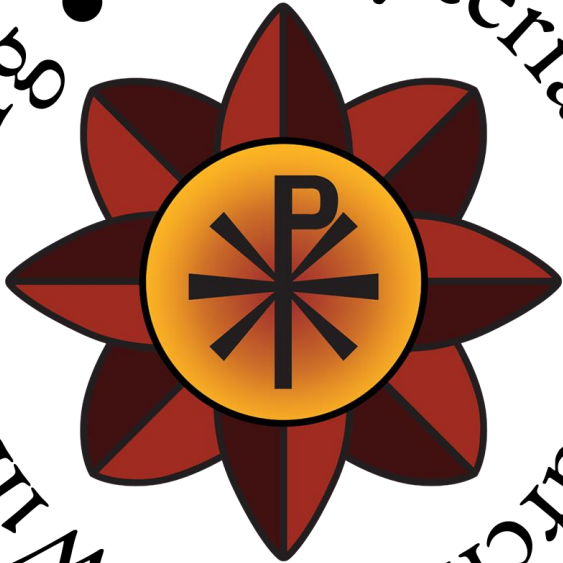

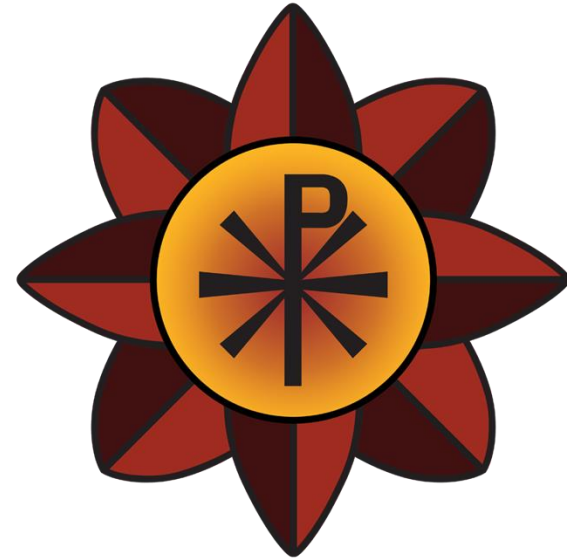
