Week 1: Spiritual Blessings in Christ — Ephesians 1

Theme: Our identity and blessings in Christ

- Explore God's eternal plan of election, redemption, and adoption.
- Discuss what it means to be sealed with the Holy Spirit.
- Reflect on how being chosen by God shapes our confidence and purpose.

Key Verse: "Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ." — *Ephesians 1:3*

Key Verse: "I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power... to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ." — *Ephesians 3:17–18*

Week 4: Unity in the Body of Christ — Ephesians 4

Theme: Living out our unity and maturity in Christ

- Discuss the call to **oneness**—one body, one Spirit, one Lord.

- Apply Paul's challenge to live worthy of our calling with humility and patience.
- Key Verse: "Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace."

Week 5: Living as Children of Light — Ephesians 5

Theme: Walking in love, purity, and wisdom

- Discover what it means to **imitate God** and live a life of love.
- Reflect on marriage as a picture of Christ and the Church.
- Discuss practical ways to live as **children of light** in a dark world.

■ Key Verse: "Follow God's example, therefore, as dearly loved children and walk in the way of love." — *Ephesians 5:1–2*

Week 6: Spiritual Warfare and Final Greetings — Ephesians 6

Theme: Standing firm in God's strength

- Examine the **armor of God** and how each piece equips believers for battle.
- Reflect on the power of prayer, perseverance, and community.
- Conclude with Paul's encouragement to stand strong and stay connected in faith.
- Wey Verse: "Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes." Ephesians 6:11
