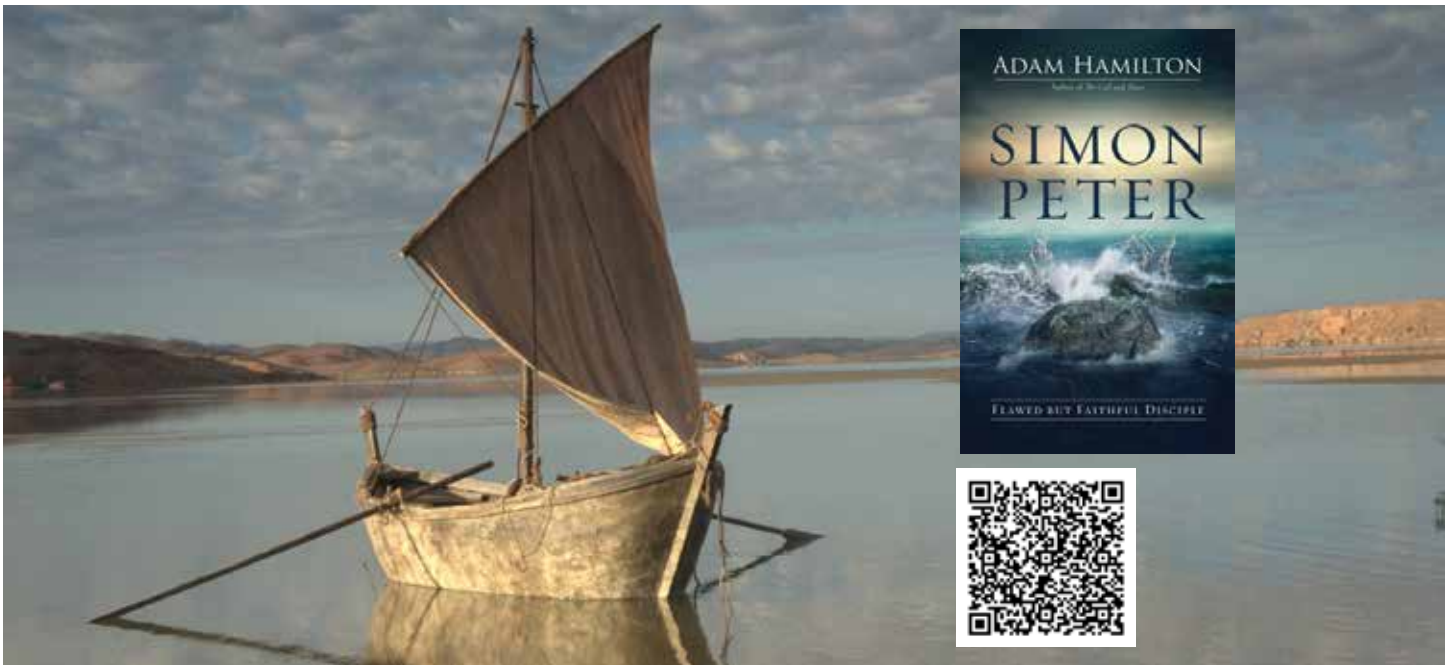

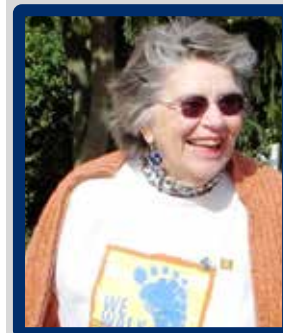
CROP Hunger Walk | Sunday, October 13 Will you join the Walk to fight hunger here and throughout the world?
