

Specific Questions: Text: Luke 1:5-20; 26-38

1. Have you ever realized you needed to move back to God? What helped you do that?
2. When God seems to delay answering a prayer, how do you respond? What do you think the delay indicates?
3. Luke 1:6 says of Zachariah and Elizabeth that “both [were] righteous before God, walking blamelessly in all the commandments and statutes of the Lord”.
 - 3.1. In v18 Zachariah expresses unbelief about the promises of Gabriel. What was the nature of his unbelief?
 - 3.2. How does that relate to v6?
 - 3.3. How is that dilemma instructive for our journey of faith?
4. In your journey with Jesus, what kinds of guidance do you seek in the following areas:
 - 4.1. relating to difficult family members (such as a ‘prodigal’)
 - 4.2. major financial decisions
 - 4.3. sharing the Gospel with the lost
