Specific Questions: Text: Exodus 32-34

- 2. Why do Christians today seem to struggle with faithful obedience to God?
- 3. Many churches experience decline (for a variety of reasons). Why do you think it is rare for churches to address those issues corporately, and as a Body?
- 4. What are some examples of people making bad choices because they didn't want to wait? What is the significance of "patience" being part of the fruit of the Spirit (Gal 5:22-23)?
- 5. What are some ways you have seen God intervene to bring discipline and correction to resolve spiritual decline?
- 6. Why didn't God say to Moses, "be careful with those tablets, they're breakable?"
- 7. Read Exodus 34:27-28. What do you think the people were saying during those 40 days?
