4. Simon was "cautious" when he answered Jesus in v43. In your response to Jesus, are you more like Simon or the woman (cautious or confident)? How does the concept that worship expresses our gratitude for being forgiven shape your thoughts about your worship?
5. Describe one way you have become a better worshiper because of corporate worship/
6. What is one way you could help the curious, weary, or lonely respond to Jesus call in worship?
