1. What are some “little things” that you routinely do? Why do you do them?
2. Some Christians treat their salvation as a “ticket to heaven” or a “get out of jail free” card. What has been your perspective of the impact your life on earth will have on your experience in heaven?
3. The apostle Paul says, “Test yourselves to see if you are in the faith...” (2Cor 13:5). Have you passed the test?
4. In what areas do you most consistently abide? What areas need greater consistency?
5. When Jesus appears (or you appear before Him) will you have confidence or shame? Why?
6. How does fellowship between believers help prepare us for eternity? Can the relationship between believers undermine our readiness to stand before Jesus? How?
