- 2. Some Christians treat their salvation as a "ticket to heaven" or a "get out of jail free" card. What has been your perspective of the impact your life on earth will have on your experience in heaven?
- 3. The apostle Paul says, "Test yourselves to see if you are in the faith..." (2Cor 13:5). Have you passed the test?
- 4. In what areas do you most consistently abide? What areas need greater consistency?
- 5. When Jesus appears (or you appear before Him) will you have confidence or shame? Why?
- 6. How does fellowship between believers help prepare us for eternity? Can the relationship between believers undermine our readiness to stand before Jesus? How?
