2. Do you think that is something we need to be concerned about today?
3. Read 1John 5:5. If someone believes that Jesus was only a man, what is the implication of verse five for them?
4. Read 1John 5:11-12. If someone believes Jesus is just a man can they have the one called “the Son” in verses 11 and 12? If not, what is true of them?
5. read 1John 2:19-23 and 5:11-12. Do you think churches today should have very many people were unsure of their salvation? Why?
6. On a scale of 1 to 10 are you confident that you have eternal life? Why?
7. How does the certainty John offers in verse 13 shape your life today?
