

Specific Questions: Text: John 10:25-30

- When you trusted Jesus for salvation, did He know about the sins you previously committed?
- When you trusted Jesus for salvation, did He know about the sins you would commit that day?
- When you trusted Jesus for salvation, did He know about the sins you would commit in the future?

- Read together the following verses:

1Pet 3:18

Rom 6:10

1Cor 15:3

Gal 1:4

Heb 10:12

- On the basis of those declarations, Jesus saved us knowing all sins. Is there any sin one could commit, that would cause Jesus to withdraw His forgiveness?
- Is there any sin He didn't know about that would cause Him to release us from His grip (Jn 10:25-30)?
