- 1. Describe a time you're caught off-guard, because you were unprepared, and it had a negative outcome. How did that change you?
- 2. Have you encountered rejection or ridicule for your faith in Christ? How did you respond? If/when it happens again, how will your response be different?
- 3. According to 1Pet 4:14 how does God give us strength to endure spiritual opposition? Hw well do you benefit from that resource?
- 4. How does the warning in 4:15 help you prepare for persecution?
- 5. Why might the label "Christian" appear only 3 times in the New Testament? Is it good that the label is so common today? Why?
- 6. Murder and theft are clear concepts in our language. What does "evil" include (biblically) that Christians might commit?
- 7. Suppose a church became convicted by the exhortation of 4:17 and they came to you for counsel wanting to know how to apply that admonition. How would you counsel them?
