- 4. What encumbrances do you need to lay aside at this stage of your journey with Jesus? if that's too personal, what are some encumbrances common to our culture that you see as common among Christians?
- 5. We don't have Jesus physically present. What disciplines have helped you keep your eyes on him? (12:2)
- 6. In terms of strengthening hands and knees, and making a straight paths, what are some ways those exhortations could apply to Refuge Church? (consider 1Tim 2:8; Acts 20:35; Phil 4:2-3; 1Pet 4:10-11)
