1. Love is foundational (Jn 13:34-34; 15:12) to Christian relationships. In general terms (no names, please) what do you find difficult to love in the conduct of other Christian? What is an example in Jesus' life of how He loved a person like that?
2. Stability requires strengthening of our faith. What is one practical way you have learned to strengthen your faith?
3. What is one way you have been trained to serve the Body of Christ? Is there an area you need training to serve better?
4. "Comfort is the removal of anxiety over affliction, not the removal of affliction and distress." Describe how comfort has helped you manage afflictions and anxiety.
5. Describe a couple of ways Refuge has aided your spiritual growth?
6. Is your spiritual stability better described as a "blameless heart" or a "wobbly heart"? Pray for one another's spiritual stability.
