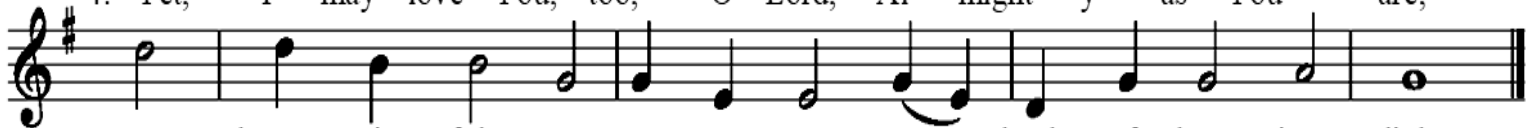

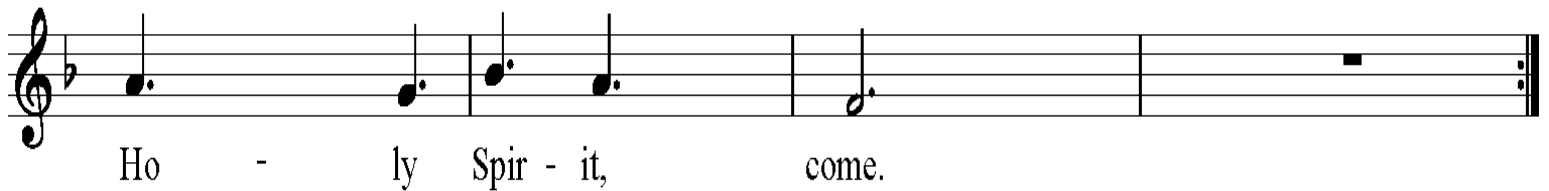
Acts 19:4-7



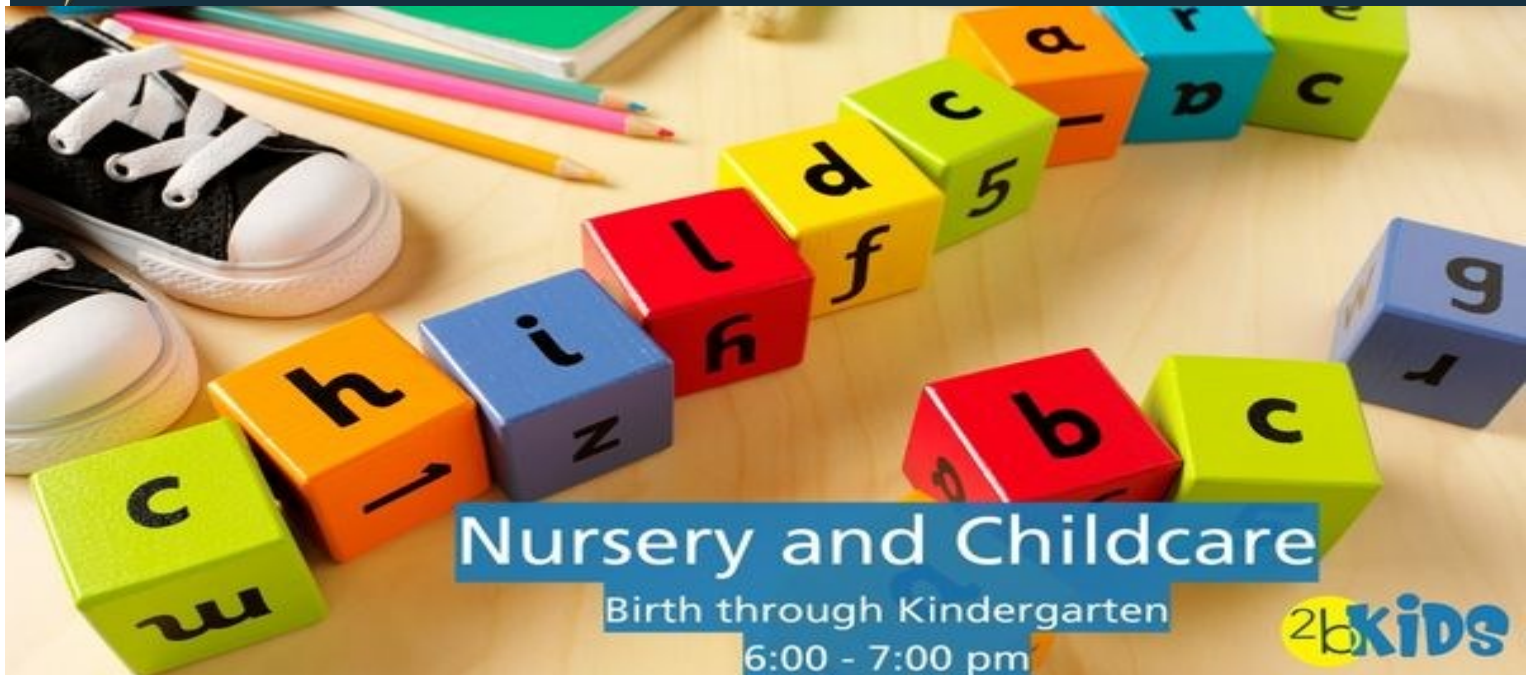
