WHEN OUR NEIGHBORS ARE HUNGRY, OUR FAITH CALLS US TO ACT

Hunger affects 5.4 million Texans, including children, seniors, working families, and people in our own congregations.

Each month, **SNAP** helps around 3.5 million Texans afford groceries during difficult times, including illness, job loss, emergencies, and rising living costs.

90% OF FOOD ASSISTANCE IN TEXAS COMES FROM SNAP | 10% OF FOOD ASSISTANCE IN TEXAS COMES FROM CHARITABLE GROUPS

Our churches and food ministries do extraordinary work, but they cannot meet this need alone.

This moment is urgent. Beginning in 2028, Texas may need nearly \$1 billion more to maintain SNAP at its current level. Raising our voices now can show decision-makers the statewide support needed to protect this essential program ahead of the January 2027 legislative session.

A Call to Feed the Hungry is a nonpartisan effort supporting SNAP. It is not a campaign for a candidate or political party, and there is no petition. Our goal is to work with Texas decision-makers to protect this essential program.

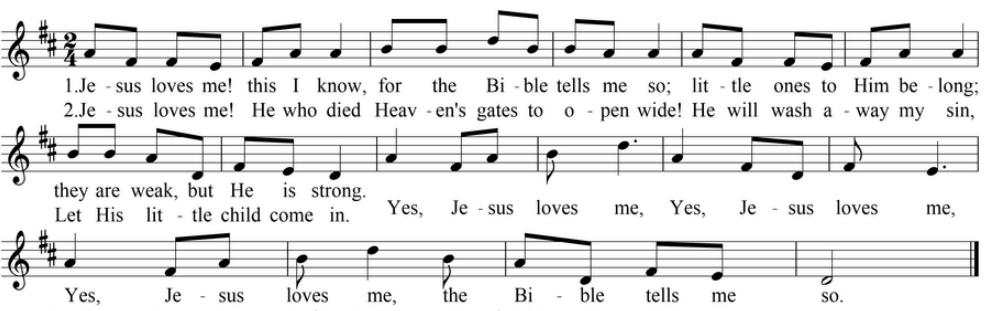
Following the Blessing of the Backpacks, all children returning to the Children's Wing are invited to Room 102.

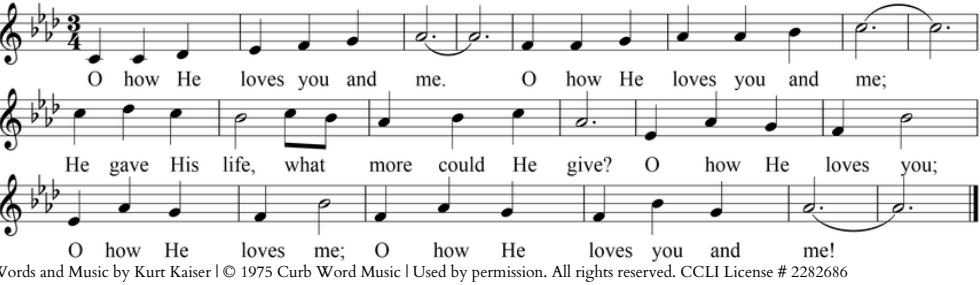

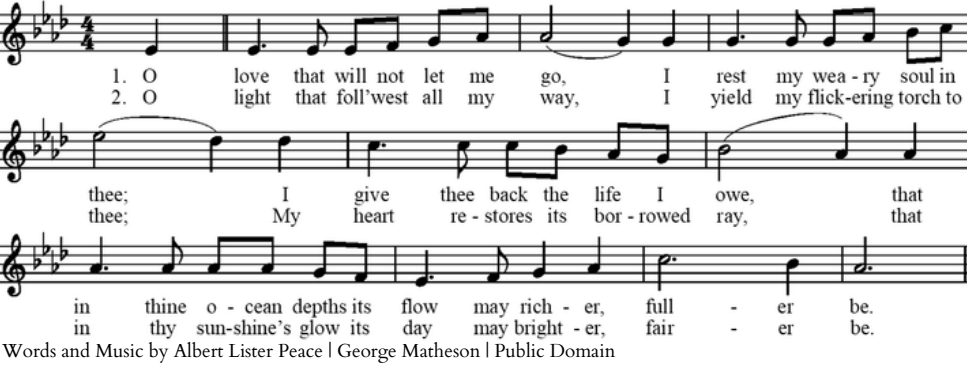

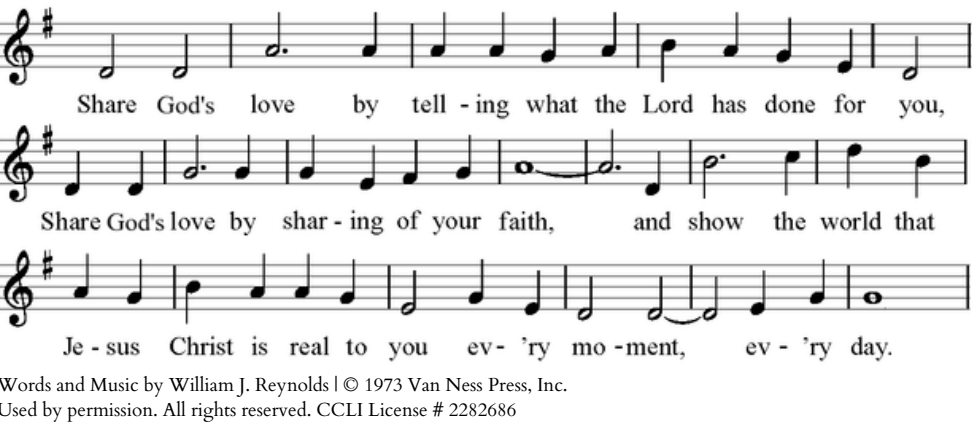
