GET IN THE GAME – NO. 3 Letting God Use Your Experiences

Theme: God wants to use our key life experiences for our good and the benefit of others!

You are a unique combination of numerous factors. We're summarizing these factors in an acronym based on the word DESIGN:

Desires + Experiences + Skills + Individuality + spiritual Gifts = Niche (what it is that God shaped and formed us to do).

Today we want to look at the second of these five factors: How God has custom-designed the experiences that help define who you are. He wants to use your key experiences for your good and for the benefit of others.

 - Helping you rely on God's power
 - Increasing your faith in God's promises
 - Encouraging others in prayer and praise
