Born physically blind into a Muslim family in Iran, Ahmad encountered the life-changing message of Jesus while living as a refugee in Turkey in 2008. Now a missionary with Converge and Founder of House of Omeed, he leads a ministry that shares the gospel with Muslims in North America and supports persecuted believers across the Middle East. In his message, Ahmad will challenge the church to embrace missions not as a program, but as its very purpose—calling believers to love and witness “here, near, and far.” With powerful stories and deep conviction, he invites us to join God’s global mission so that every nation may worship before His throne.
