Hi! I attend Calvary Church with my kids and husband. About 2 years ago I started suffering dramatic weight loss and still struggle to eat even a few bites of food without severe pain most of the time. It's been a difficult and challenging journey to navigate and grieve the loss of something so natural to the course of your day, especially since I love cooking and baking. The daily pain (even when I'm not eating), all the specialists visits, doctors telling me it's all in my head has been exhausting while also trying to work and still be present with my family. I know the only way that I have been able to get through this is God is with me. I have recently written down a few things so I can look at them during the day to remember God's truths. since it's easy to get distracted by all of the above, and I wanted to share them: God is the great healer. He can heal with one touch; one word. If I'm not healed yet, I still believe and I still have hope. If I am never healed, I still believe and trust in God. Just because my prayers have not been answered yet, does not mean God does not care for me or love me, it means I don't yet understand His perfect plan. If He did not care, he would not be opening doors/paths into specialty clinics which are really difficult to get into. He helped me get parental nutrition (I eat through my vein) when I needed it. He is guiding my way to help. Although it's slower than I would like, it's God's masterful timing. Some days are really hard, but I don't break down in panic (most of the time - I am only human ha ha) because I know he's got this. There is no way I would have the strength to endure this on my own, I know it's coming from Him - God is with me.

After service prayer ministry (ASP) is an opportunity for anyone to come forward after any Sunday services and receive prayer.

Of course we encourage a response of prayer in any form after a worship service. This is a special way to do that and also be encouraged by the prayer ministers who will join you in your prayer. When you come forward you're coming to connect to Jesus. The prayer ministers' role is to be an escort and guide in that connection to Jesus.

After service prayer ministers go through an application and training process. There is no minimum commitment and scheduling is done via Google sheet by the month. Calvary Prayer ministry works closely with Calvary Care ministries to meet the spiritual, emotional, mental, and physical needs of individuals.

• Pray for existing elders and new elders that will be coming on the board July 1 and several new committee members on various committees.


• Cover all our graduating seniors in both HS and college.
