- Co-lead pre- and post-gathering leadership team meetings on Tuesday nights, encouraging leaders to notice and name God's activity throughout the gathering
- Set up equipment for preteen gatherings on Tuesday nights and youth gatherings on Thursday nights
- Foster meaningful connections with youth and preteens who are present for Sunday morning worship gatherings by greeting them by name and having conversations with them
- Manage our next-gen social media accounts (youth, preteen, and young adults), which includes creating and posting engaging event graphics
- Purchase and prepare food & snack for youth gatherings on Tuesday and Thursday nights
- Assist the Youth & Young Adults director with preparing and executing special Youth Signature Events, which occur every 6 weeks
- Minister to and shepherd youth and preteens as they go deeper in their faith with Jesus
- Help foster a ministry culture of presence to God and each other
- Take ownership of inviting new people to serve on a regular basis
