Board of Trustees June Meeting Update

- New Trustees welcomed Emma Huff, Erica Kersten, Marni Barron, and Paul Chotlos joined continuing Trustees Nancy Emmert, Bill Fiore, and Bill Hausler.
- Discussion on the following issues: ant infestation, exterior painting, sanctuary sound system upgrade, tuck pointing and brick repair on the bell tower.
- Approved needed repairs for the organ.
- FBC was selected as 1 of 30 churches to participate in the *Focus on Energy Program*. This includes an energy audit, with MG&E covering up to 75% of implementation costs if recommendations are pursued by the church.
- Carl Johnson began training and duties for the new part-time Rental Manager position in early June.
- While not discussed at this meeting, the Trustee Annual Report noted the installation of "PRIVATE" signs on certain rooms (church office, pastor's office, etc.) to protect sensitive information. This step is in response to increased ICE (Immigration and Customs Enforcement) activity and related privacy concerns.

- Wrong bags Only use see-through bags if bagging your recycling.
- 2. No clothing or textiles These do not belong in the recycling cart.
- 3. No Styrofoam Take it to a drop-off site.
- 4. No tanglers Hoses, ropes, loose plastic bags, or shower curtains cause problems.
- 5. No wood or lumber These are not accepted in recycling carts.
