

The church continues to receive your kind donations to two denominational offerings: One Great Hour of Sharing and America for Christ. One Great Hour of Sharing (taken in cooperation with eight other denominations) supports disaster relief, ministries to refugees, and development projects here in the United States and throughout the world. Through the America for Christ offering, American Baptist Home Mission Societies (ABHMS) provide financial support for existing and new innovative ministries by American Baptist churches and affiliated organizations across the United States and Puerto Rico.

Madison Celebrates Installation of First Air Quality Monitor

Madison is installing a city-wide network of air quality sensors to help understand pollution in our community funded by the Environmental Protection Agency.

This new monitoring network will gather data that can be communicated to residents regarding their local exposure to pollution. These 56 sensors will be installed on Cityowned street poles, at various City parks, and at certain partner organizations.

Air pollution has negative impacts on health, causing cardiovascular and respiratory illnesses, vascular dementia, and low birth weights. Vehicle, woodfire, and coal combustion emissions are associated with air pollutants and ozone, sulfur oxides and nitrogen oxides.
