

Inflation Reduction Act Programs

Wisconsin is the first state to be approved to administer Biden's Inflation Reduction Act money. The plan has two Home Energy Rebate programs that are available to single, and multifamily homes and non-profits. The HOMES program is now available for rebates on whole home improvements including heating, cooling and insulation. The HEAR program begins in September for Home Electrification and Appliance Rebates.

Key items from the August meeting:

- Our liability/building insurance premium will rise significantly in 2025. We have chosen the least expensive renewal option, which will limit replacement cost and increase the deductible. We may choose to raise the coverage level in the future.
- We discussed a request to add poetry (from past/present members) to our church gardens and how/when that might be done.
- An additional meeting is necessary for our treasurer, bookkeeper, and an accountant to resolve a remaining bookkeeping issue.
- We received a quarterly report from the Investment & Planned Giving Committee.
- Pastor Tim reviewed upcoming worship, advocacy, and events since many involve building use.
