## A Note From the Pastor

This year's American Baptist Churches of Wisconsin Annual Gathering, followed by a special LGBTQ-focused worship service at First Baptist, was a powerful reminder of the gifts and challenges of our ABC-WI family. I was inspired by the racial, cultural, and theological diversity celebrated across our ABC community, the vital work on immigration advocacy, and efforts to educate congregations about the dangers that white Christian nationalism pose to our communities.



Yet, our guest preacher reminded us that many of our congregations remain ambiguous about LGBTQ+ inclusion. And this is certainly true of our ABC region. This year marked the first time I have heard LGBTQ+ justice explicitly named in an Annual Gathering. And we remain the only explicitly LGBTQ+ affirming congregation in our region. Friends, there is still work for us to do and allies to be recruited to the work of God's justice which we hold sacred.

## Minimize Plastic Use in the Kitchen

- Use wooden or bamboo cutting boards
- Store food in glass, metal, ceramic, beeswax paper or aluminum foil
- Microwave only in ceramic or glass heat releases plastic particles
- Choose metal cookware and metal or wooden utensils instead of plastic or nonstick pans
- Avoid beverages in plastic use metal or glass bottles
- Don't put plastic in the dishwasher. It sheds microplastics
- Use cotton, hemp, or canvas reusable bags and produce bags
- Less processed foods not packaged in plastic; choose items in cans or glass jars
