#### **Lunch Bunch**

Lunch Bunch is an optional program that requires advance registration and payment. #### **Clothing**

Please be sure to label all clothes, jackets, and school bags with your child's name. Many children do not recognize their own belongings when there are several others that look similar. Especially new jackets!

All snacks must be nut free – that includes peanuts and tree nuts. We cannot serve items that have been processed or packaged in a facility that also processes or packages nut products. Snacks must be store bought with labels we can read and be unopened.

Thank you for your cooperation in keeping all our students safe. We will send home any snack that doesn't meet our guidelines.

#### **Tuition**

Thank you for your timely tuition payments. They are **due the first of each month**. The best way to pay is on the preschool payment page on our website.

If your child is going to be out of school due to illness or travel, please email your child's teacher or the preschool office.
