



Field Trip

to TEMPLE HALL FARM

This beautiful working farm provides an opportunity for children and adults to learn about farm animals and to enjoy the sites and sounds of the farm. This farm is designed as an outdoor classroom and educates children about the diverse aspects of farm life, animals and crops. A farm interpreter leads the tour and guides children as they participate in farm-related activities.

- **Thursday, April 23** – Charming Chimps & Bouncy Birds

Classes will **meet at 9:45 am** in the parking lot of Temple Hall Farm Regional Park in Leesburg.

All students must be accompanied and supervised by an adult (other than our staff) and siblings are welcome. **The cost is \$10/person ages 2 and up (including your preschooler).** Children under 2 are free.

Remember to wear appropriate clothing and shoes for outside activities. (In case of an extremely rainy day, we will email a message with alternative plans.)

There are picnic tables and a playground, so you are welcome to bring a picnic lunch or snack to eat with the other preschool families after the tour as a fun fellowship time before you head home.

Directions: Temple Hall Farm Regional Park is located 5 miles north of Leesburg. Take Route 15 or Route 15 Bypass North from Leesburg to right on Limestone School Road (Route 661). Follow for $\frac{3}{4}$ mile to the park entrance on the left. (15789 Temple Hall Lane, Leesburg, Virginia 20176)
