

# **Becoming Disciple-makers**

Do you remember singing the chorus — "I Have Decided to Follow Jesus"? The message of this song hinges upon the word 'decide'. Following Jesus is a choice — a decision each person intentionally makes. The chorus emphasizes the seriousness of following Jesus when it affirms — 'No Turning Back, No Turning Back'.

Do you remember when you decided to follow Jesus? Do you remember how your decision came about? No doubt someone cared enough for you that they shared the gospel of Jesus Christ with you. 
