Dear Church Family,

First Baptist Church has once again experienced the blessing of God in 2025. We've experienced God's working again and again in and through our congregation. God has worked through the generous giving of His people to meet our ministry's financial needs this year.

As we look to the future, now is the time for us to commit to our 2026 church budget. This budget appeared in last week's Clarion and additional copies are available today at the Info Desk in the Worship Center foyer. The budget provides the details of where funds will be directed across our ministry areas as God provides throughout the coming year. This year's budget reflects a 2.61% increase over our 2025 budget. The primary increases occur in staff support, facilities support, and missions.

You will notice that our budget line items are arranged to reflect the five purposes of the church: Worship, Evangelism, Fellowship, Discipleship, and Ministry. This serves as a reminder of our church's mission "Calling Every Believer to Become a Disciple-maker of Jesus where they live, work, and play."

Please take a few moments to prayerfully consider the proposed budget for 2026. It represents the combined ministry plans of thirty committees and/or ministries and six full time staff. A word of thanks is in order for those members of our thirty committees and/or ministries for their dedication and hard work. Another word of thanks goes out to Chris Dampier, our Church Business Administrator, Alex Rainey, our Administrative Assistant - Financial, and the Stewardship Committee for their work in compiling the budget and overseeing the finances of the church throughout the year: Terry Scott (Chair), Jason Bradford, Heidi Condrey, Brad Lane, John Richburg, and Jody Singleton.

The Stewardship Committee has already presented the budget to the Deacon Council which unanimously supports the budget and now recommends it to the church. The church family had the opportunity to discuss the proposed budget during last Wednesday's (November 19th) Special Business Meeting. This morning a vote for approval from all church members present will be taken during the Worship Service.

The stewardship giving of our church tells a lot about who we are as disciples. It tells we believe in being a Christian steward, that we believe in the local church, and that we all desire to honor God through our giving.

May our light shine so others may see our good works and glorify our Father who is in Heaven (Matt. 5:16).
