


Advent Resources for Families


Want to help make Advent more engaging for your whole family? Looking for a new Advent devotional or a way to start new Advent traditions for your family?
















Who Built the Stable?


A Nativity Poem

A board-book child's of the Christmas story with great illustrations! It's got great retelling of Scripture, even from Old Testament, of signficance of Jesus' birth.


May be a little wordy for some kids.






Advent Books 25 Days of the

This is a daily Advent devotional that goes through all 4 weeks of the Advent, not just 25 days of December.


This is a good resource for parents who want something they can read and reflect on and then use as a way to engage in family conversation.
