FAQ

What if I pledge but need to make a change?

Is there a penalty if I miss giving or need to pause my giving?

No. We will never do anything that penalizes people on their giving. Throughout the year, we provide giving statements so that you can track your giving, but this is not a bill.

How is my giving distributed to ministry?

All giving for the operating budget goes toward the use of programs, staff, buildings, and outreach.

How do I decide what to do?

We invite each person and family to prayerfully and wisely consider their own giving. You may choose to do a percentage of your income and regularly give that amount throughout the year. Some may choose to give all at once, each week, each month, or as they are able throughout the year.
