Description

The Middle School Ministry Assistant Director has primary responsibility for the carrying out the vision and strategy of the Gloria Dei Youth from fifth through eighth grade school ministry and contributes to our mission by fostering a culture of discipleship that results in support of increased sending capacity beyond Gloria Dei and leads a professional and personal life that does not violate the teachings and beliefs of the Lutheran Church Missouri Synod on matters of personal conduct.

Duties:

- 1. Coordinate volunteer teams to ensure full staffing in Sunday environments.
- 2. Ensure supplies are ordered and accessible to the Leaders and all materials are printed, to include the weekly set up of the check-in stations.
- 3. Assist in implementing a Bible-based curriculum for Middle School Ministry at Gloria Dei, including but not limited to Sunday morning and evening, age-specific opportunities.
- 4. Assist in implementing special events for families of all ages, and age-specific opportunities, within the Family Life Team.
- 5. Provide a safe and secure environment within your responsibilities.
- 6. Model a lifestyle which is seeking to grow as a fully devoted follower of Jesus Christ.
- 7. Participate in other ministry assignments as mutually agreed.

Qualifications:

- Four-year degree, education preferred.
- Three to five years' experience
- Passion to work with the Youth.

This salary position is a ministerial exception position, minimum 40 hours per week which includes Sunday mornings and evenings and reports directly to the Director of Family Life. Because of the nature of this ministry, flexibility in scheduling is required.
