Mark & Jenny Ellefson Burundi

The Ellefson family moved to Burundi in August of 2022. Located in the heart of Africa, Burundi is the second poorest country in the world. Their vision is to support indigenous movements of God by coming alongside local ministries and churches through consultancy and training.

- Please pray for health and protection for their family and for their daughters attending an American international school in Bujumbura.
- Pray for ongoing partnerships to help bring great increase for the Kingdom of God in the great lakes region of Africa.
- Pray for the launch of the first Mission Training School to train local Burundian missionaries. There are 18 trainees in this first year.
- Pray for the 12 leaders with the opportunity to outreach into schools in 3 provinces this year.



Andy & Brittney East Africa

Their family has been on sabbattical after needing to leave East Africa. Their business had grown, but it attracted some unwanted attention after bringing in a few larger contracts. The business was shut down by a corrupt local official who wanted a bribe they wouldn't pay and who was trying to funnel money to his people through the business. The business closure caused them to lose their residence visas.

• Please lift our time processing and praying about next steps for our family and where they may lead.



The 5G Family Africa

Greg, Jess, and their three boys will live on the edge of the Sahara Desert starting in November 2023. Their primary desire is to see Christ's church, fruitful and growing, in this place where it is not yet known to exist. They are engaged in full-time culture and language learning as well as business research so that, long-term, they can run a business that integrates them in the community and provides relationships to sow and, Lord willing, water Gospel seeds. They are trying to do these things while also keeping up with their three young boys.

- Pray that we will consistently grow in abiding in Jesus for what we need.
- Pray for grace to learn the local culture and language efficiently yet relationally.
- Pray for groups of locals who will repent of sin, believe in Christ, and follow the Holy Spirit.

Katie has spent the last 12 years involved in the education of elementaryaged children. The schools she has worked at cater to the field worker community but also bring in many local families. Katie is also part of a team whose focus is to look for opportunities to engage with those around them who are seeking truth in this predominantly Muslim country.

- Pray for opportunities with our neighbors, shop keepers, friends, and language tutors. We want to boldly share when we are given opportunities. We ask for more hungry and thirsty people to cross paths with so we can share our reason for hope.
- Pray for the country which continues to struggle post-Arab Spring. We need leaders with integrity who can bring about economic, social, and political stability.



Dr. Gina Wintermantel (Hazel, Abraham, Josiah, Cyrus) *Christian Veterinary Mission / AIM* | *Torit, South Sudan*

Gina and Steve have served in South Sudan for the past five years, partnering with African pastors to launch Kingdom Builders School (KBS), a disciple-making school to equip both men and women who have been called to take the Good News of Jesus Christ to unreached people in South Sudan. KBS has also developed a demonstration farm to provide training in agriculture and animal husbandry for KBS students and the community. Gina and Steve's plan for the coming year was to place oversight for this ministry in the hands of nationals while they served at Rift Valley Academy where their two youngest children are completing high school. Regular visits to South Sudan to evaluate and give direction to KBS were also planned. Steve, however, suffered cardiac arrest while being cared for in Nairobi, Kenya, and stepped into the Lord's presence on June 13, 2023. Gina will continue to follow through with their plan to serve the Lord at both Rift Valley Academy and to give direction to KBS as it continues to grow.

- Pray that God will continue to bring Kingdom Builder students and that the leaders will be faithful to equip and encourage the students.
- Pray for our family as we grieve the loss of Steve and yet continue forward with God's plan for each of our lives. May He be our strength and grant us the peace that sur-

passes all understanding.

 Pray that Gina will develop deep relationships with students at RVA and encourage these young men and women to deepen their relationship with God.



John Philip Omot SIM | Ethiopia/Worldwide

John is a pastor who provides introductory training on trauma awareness and resilience. He also is involved in peacebuilding in the Sudan Jonglei Food Security Project. The targeted people are traditional leaders, local government leaders, church leaders, women in leadership, and youth leaders.

- Prayers for the Murle tribe, as they are in conflict with all tribes bordering them.
- Prayers for the Pochalla South and Pochalla North Anyuak conflict.



The W Family North Africa

As field project manager for Bible translation projects, Tom's responsibility is to find and qualify new translation projects. There are approximately 45 languages remaining in this country without one verse of Scripture in their mother tongue. Tom monitors and supports these projects. Ninra has been teaching New Testament in a Bible college for the last 10 years. After her marriage to Tom in June, Ninra has relocated to Tom's city and is focusing on improving her English proficiency.

• Pray that we would serve in God's Kingdom so that 1+1=3 or even 4 or 5. Please pray for Ninra as she prepares to go back to school to get a master's in counseling. This may involve a temporary move to a nearby country for a few years where Tom would work mainly remotely.



Mike & Maria Partners International | Southeast Asia

Additionally, they work with existing Christians to equip them to reach out to the Muslims who work in their offices, live next door, or attend the same school as them.

They desire to see a church planting movement of 100 reproducing churches in the region where they have put their focus.

Dan and Devri have been sharing the Gospel with Turkish speaking Muslims since 1985, with 28 years in Turkey and now 10 years in Northern Cyprus. They are currently involved in hosting and overseeing the Shiloh International Fellowship; vetting, training, and encouraging new FAI missionaries who want to work with Muslims in the Middle East; and mentoring Turkish church leaders and new workers on the field. Dan has written a number of books, many of which have been translated into languages of the Middle East (danwickwire.com). Dan and Devri frequently give seminars on how to share the Gospel effectively with Muslims, and they are daily involved in a prayer house ministry.

They serve as the ministry coordinators of the Discipleship Training School (DTS) which is YWAM's foundational training course, seeking to draw students into a deeper relationship with God and release them into missional lives. Students engage in three months of lectures on a wide variety of topics oriented towards intimacy with God and mission. Following these three months, the students experience a two month, cross-cultural outreach to share the message of love that they experienced in their own lives. Samuel and Karis' roles include oversight of staff training and care, DTS students and courses, and outreach locations and focus.

They provide oversight to the Finance, Personnel, and Aviation Teams as well as IT support for the systems they use. This provides critical infrastructure for frontline church planters and translators as they serve among isolated people groups across Indonesia. Josh also collaborates with a broader IT team to offer similar resources and technical support to other Ethnos affiliates around the world.

- Pray for Josh for clear communication to manage projects and to train and support colleagues from thirteen time zones away.
- Pray for discernment for Josie as she provides Christian counseling and resources to the Ethnos360 Personnel Office, Elmbrook Church Care Team, and others the Lord brings her way.

Day to day they share their faith with lost students across the city, meet to disciple Christian student leaders, lead Bible studies, speak and teach at student gatherings, and train and equip students to love Jesus, lead their peers, and live out their faith for a lifetime. God has given them a vision to raise up students who will love Jesus, live as disciples of Christ, and make disciples on their campuses.

They initiate new platforms in society for ministry, Bible study groups, seminary teaching, sermons in churches, and counseling, enabling national laborers in creative outreach enterprises, aiming at spiritual transformation, social impact, and financial selfsustainability.

 Pray for God's discernment and wisdom to know how to best serve, encourage, support our friends and family in Christ in Ukraine, while the war and fighting continues, and afterwards. There are many physical, emotional, and practical needs that will continue as time goes by. Pray that we may be a bright light in the darkness, helping people see and understand that in the Lord, they will find true refuge, security, and safety. (Ps. 46 & 57).

- Pray for God's leading in choosing the projects and people to be involved with amongst a variety of opportunities. Pray for spiritual wisdom and depth of insight that we may know where to put our efforts most effectively (Colossians 1:9-10).

Tyrannus and Lydia Halls | Central Europe / South Asia

God has called Steve and Julie into positions where they teach, disciple, and mentor both Christian students and Christian leaders in Central Europe and South Asia. Their most literal and accurate ministry description is "to engage deeply with God and engage deeply with others." Steve regularly visits 20 ministry sites in 8 countries, with Julie joining him when she can. These ministry sites are called either a Tyrannus Hall (for men) or a Lydia Hall (for women). They are residential discipleship centers where typically 8-20 university students live together in community and are discipled during their university years. Outside of Tyrannus and Lydia Halls, Steve and Julie engage weekly or bi-weekly in deep Kingdom-focused relationships with individual elders, pastors and missionaries as well as with couples in Christian leadership.

- Pray for spiritual growth unto Christlikeness for our 300+ university students in multiyear, residential discipleship communities (4 in Europe, 18 in Asia).
- Pray for us as we transition back to the US after 30 years in Europe to oversee the newly reorganized Tyrannus and Lydia Halls mission organization.

Mariano and Fanny live and work on the Camino de Santiago (St. James Way), an ancient pilgrimage that each year draws hundreds of thousands of people from all over the world. Together they founded Wandering Monks, a non-profit that seeks to foster the spiritual development of all people. They focus their work in three main areas: hospitality (through Casa de Pan, a guest house right on the Camino), soul care (through one-on-one spiritual direction and group retreats), and spiritual formation (through the ministry of the written word, guiding groups on the Camino, and Godly Play[®]).

- Pray for us as we lead and cast vision for Wandering Monks and Casa de Pan. Pray for wisdom and direction from the Holy Spirit.

Congo Initiative

The Congo Initiative is an envisioned community of Christcentered Congolese leaders and global partners united for the transformation of lives in a flourishing Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC). Our core catalyst of change is the Christian Bilingual University of Congo (UCBC), a fouryear university equipping changemakers and holistically renewing communities through transformative education and community engagement initiatives. The university has over 400 students enrolled each year and over 800 alumni working to improve livelihoods in the DRC and around the world. Elmbrook's partnership helps build the capacity of



staff, educators, and leadership, ultimately empowering them to equip the next generation of leaders and create lasting change in the DRC.

In North India, Operation Mobilization partners with Nicodemus Trust, an organization upholding God's call to serve by providing those in need with better medical care, education, and living conditions. It is living out its motto of "Restoring the image of God to the suffering humanity." Many people in North India are forced

to live in acute poverty where physical, emotional, and social needs are not met. Nicodemus Trust works through focused projects in four major areas – child education, healthcare for families, skills training and livelihood for youth, and community engagement through women empowerment. When Covid had a devastating impact on many communities in North India, Elmbook partnered with Nicodemus Trust to provide relief through food distribution to many hurting people.

• Pray for the 200 million Muslims of North India, one of the greatest challenges and areas of need among all unreached people in the world of missions today.





• Pray for Sushil who is the leader of the national Nicodemus Trust ministry and is also the South Asia Coordinator for Vision 5:9, a network of about 80 mission agencies and churches working together to finish the task of reaching every Muslim unreached people group in India.

JAMES PLACE WASHINGTON HIGH SCHOOL

This location assists high school students with tutoring, job applications, life skills, and college prep. It is a place where students can come and be listened to and where encouragement and hope are offered as they plan for life after high school.

JAMES PLACE OBAMA SCHOOL

This location is a place of peace where students and staff can receive support and prayer. Students can also come to work on schoolwork and get tutoring. There also are volunteers placed in classrooms to support teachers and build relationships with the students they serve.

JAMES PLACE NORTHSIDE

This location works with Partners in Hope to mentor returning citizens coming out of incarceration.

Serving our local immigrant and refugee communities in Waukesha and Milwaukee, WI, our highly trained accredited representatives provide consultation on immigration questions, help prepare and submit complex immigration forms, and provide a low-cost option for many who cannot afford expensive legal representation.

Master's level counseling interns integrate faith and mental health therapy to help others find hope again. We are always looking for licensed professional counselors with 5+ years experience to supervise students, as well as students seeking to complete their mental health counseling internship hours.
