Mark & Jenny Ellefson Burundi

The Ellefson family is supporting the advancement of the Kingdom of God in Burundi by coming alongside local ministry leaders and churches through consultancy and training. Located in the heart of Africa, Burundi is the second poorest nation in the world. The Ellefsons' vision is to see God continue to do incredible things through local leaders in one the least-resourced nations in the world. They are currently working from the USA due to instability in Burundi.

- Pray for ongoing partnerships to help advance the Kingdom of God in the Great Lakes region of Africa.
- Pray for the Missionary Training School as it trains local Burundian missionaries.

Wubshet Teklewold

Wubshet and his family serve in the southeastern part of Ethiopia, in a primarily Muslim-dominated area. They are training hundreds of Muslim-background believers (MBBs) in their training centers, planting churches, and encouraging the 390 MBBs they have commissioned and sent to the mission field. They give thanks to God that hundreds of thousands have come to Christ through their ministry in the past few years.

- We need your prayers as we continue to train more men and women MBBs to send to unreached people groups. Your prayers are crucial for our mission's success.
- Please pray for the strength and perseverance of new converts who are under persecution, intimidation, and attack.
- We need your prayers for the planned new church planting sites and evangelism among Muslims.
- Please pray for me and my family for guidance and blessings throughout our lives.



The 5G Family Africa

Greg, Jess, and their three boys are moving to a new team and city in their country at the start of 2025. Their primary desire is to see Christ's church, fruitful and growing, in this place where it is not yet known to exist. They are engaged in full-time culture and language learning as well as business research so that, long-term, they can run a business that integrates them in the community and provides relationships to sow and, Lord willing, water Gospel seeds. They are trying to do these things while also keeping up with their three young boys.

Dr. Gina Wintermantel (Hazel, Abraham, Josiah, Cyrus) Christian Veterinary Mission / AIM | Torit, South Sudan

Gina and Steve served in South Sudan together for five years, partnering with African pastors to launch Kingdom Builders School (KBS), a disciple-making school to equip both men and women who have been called to take the Good News of Jesus Christ to unreached people in South Sudan. KBS has also developed a demonstration farm to provide training in agriculture and animal husbandry for KBS students and the community. After Steve's passing in 2023, Gina has continued to walk with KBS. This year, she will be in South Sudan for six months to serve with the KBS leaders. The following six months, she will be at Rift Valley Academy (RVA) teaching physical education and mentoring students. Her youngest son will graduate from RVA in 2025.

- Pray for the KBS demonstration farm and the provision of a farm manager who has experience and loves Jesus and teaching.
- Pray for our family to stay committed to following Jesus and sharing about Him with others.
- Pray for the formation of a passionate and committed board of directors for Kingdom Builders School, and for our leaders to be sustained and fulfilled in their service.



John Philip Omot SIM | Ethiopia/Worldwide

John is a pastor who provides introductory training on trauma awareness and resilience. He also is involved in peacebuilding in the Sudan Jonglei Food Security Project. The targeted people in his ministry are traditional leaders, local government leaders, church leaders, women in leadership, and youth leaders.

The W Family North Africa

It is The W Family's joy to call North Africa home since 2010. Their hearts' desire is to make disciples who make disciples and to see every corner of their nation touched by the gospel. They partner with a local house-church group in discipleship and leadership training. As they form relationships through business, in their neighborhood, and with friends of their boys, they aim to give each a reason for the hope they have and see the Kingdom expanded in this Muslim land.

Tom & Ninra Seed Company | Southeast Asia

In the country in southeast Asia where Ninra and Tom live, there are more than 150 languages, and 45 or more do not have a single verse of Scripture. Seed Company trains and funds nationals to do the work of literacy and Bible translation. As field project manager, Tom is responsible for finding new translation projects and supporting these national leaders.

- Praise God for the way He is sustaining all of the translation projects and for the ways in which God's Word is transforming lives and communities. Continue to ask Him to grant His strength to the translators as they face war, injustice, internet and communication cuts, electricity outages, inflation, and more.
- Please pray for Ninra and Tom as they work on their masters in biblical counseling degrees online.
- Please pray for revival of the church in the midst of a brutal civil war. May God have mercy on this country.



Mike & Maria

Partners International | Southeast Asia

Their ministry focuses on training and sending out local believers to share the gospel with Muslims and to establish churches for those who respond. Additionally, they work with existing Christians to equip them to reach out to the Muslims who work in their offices, live next door, or attend the same school as them.

- Every day, we are engaged in sharing the gospel personally and through our church planters. Pray that many will come to faith.

Their vision is that these youth would be reconciled with God so they can be effective servants of positive influence in their families, communities, and churches.

- Pray for the economy as inflation has doubled the cost of living for the local people.

Mike & Rachel Southeast Asia

Mike and Rachel live in a major city of Southeast Asia among a minority unreached people group. They work alongside local people to mobilize neighborhood assets to address urban issues. They share the good news about Jesus so that people can experience restored relationships with God, self, and others.

- Pray that God will use our soccer program to empower at-risk youth to make good choices.
- Pray that God will lead us to people who are ready to follow Him and who will also share the good news of Jesus with their families.

They also serve as associate area directors for ten additional countries, building strategic partnerships and providing oversight, accountability, teaching, training, coaching, leadership development, prayer mobilization, and recruiting.

Students engage in three months of lectures on a wide variety of topics oriented towards intimacy with God and mission. Following these three months, the students experience a two month, cross-cultural outreach to share the message of love that they experienced in their own lives. S & K's' roles include oversight of staff training and care, DTS students and courses, and outreach locations and focus.


- Pray for wisdom to focus our time wisely on the many ministry needs.

They lead the movement and offer opportunities to reach non-believing athletes though teammates and coaches. Nick and Jena disciple athletes, teaching them to walk with God and give Him glory through their platform of sport, and train them to reach their teammates and others for Christ.

They invest a significant time in face-to-face relationships. Their primary mission is social and spiritual reconciliation for the purpose of evangelism and discipleship. They desire to encourage better relationships between First Nations people and Christian communities through education and example and eventually see greater numbers of Native Christians in significant ministry and leadership positions.

- Pray for God's strength, wisdom, and patience as we seek to meet the emotional and behavioral needs of our adopted and foster children.

Their aim is to reach college students with the gospel of Jesus, establish them in their faith, and equip them to be "laborers in the harvest" in their own spheres of influence, both on campus and in their lives post-graduation. They want to see students focus on individual people, with an eye towards spiritual multiplication through generations of disciple-makers.

She also facilitates workshops for local churches to help them see more of God's heart for the nations and to discern specific ways their church can be more involved in God's mission. As a prayer coordinator, Christina helps mobilize prayer from churches and newer sending centers in Latin & South America, Africa, eastern and northern Europe, and parts of Asia for the peoples of East Asia.

Right now, they help lead student movements on 10 different campuses, a few of which include: New York University, The Fashion Institute of Technology, The New School, City College of New York, Fordham University, and Manhattan College. Day to day, they share their faith with lost students across the city, meet to disciple Christian student leaders, lead Bible studies, speak and teach at student gatherings, and train and equip students to love Jesus, lead their peers, and live out their faith for a lifetime. God has given them a vision to raise up students who will love Jesus wholeheartedly, live as disciples of Christ together, and go out to make disciples on their campuses and around the world.

- Please pray that we would have Spirit-filled hope and intimacy with Jesus, for wisdom to raise our boys well in the city and meaningfully put Jesus first as a family, for breakthrough and growth in emotional and spiritual health and for humility and boldness to live out our faith in all things.

The Hamiltons also love discipling and mentoring Navigator staff serving across the US and around the world.

Some describe Fort as a "taste of heaven on earth." In 1996, Craig and Tina started their own relationship together there while both were serving. At Fort, Craig shepherds relationships with campers and staff, furthers ministry with partner church staff and leaders, walks alongside missionaries raising support, and expands partnerships for the ongoing needs and Fort Future plans. In addition to raising the family, Tina builds into campers and staff who return year after year.


- Please pray for students to be open to spiritual conversation and growth.

After working as part of a missionary team planting a church among the Yanomami people for 15 years in the village of Marari, Phil and Valeree transitioned to a full-time field leadership role in 2007. They now reside in the city of Manaus and work with a leadership team where Phil and Valeree help to mentor and shepherd missionary teams planting churches among the least reached peoples of the Amazon. They do this by clarifying vision and by providing training, guidance, and encouragement. Their present ministry involves a significant amount of travel to the numerous indigenous villages where MNTB is engaging in church planting.

- Pray for the missionary teams involved in church planting, translation, literacy, and discipleship.
- Pray for us to have wisdom as we work with the missionary teams and indigenous church leaders.

RiverWind was founded by Dick and Ruth to reach indigenous peoples in the Peruvian Amazon. RiverWind's mission includes leadership formation, community development, and environmental stewardship as they teach indigenous community and church leaders using oral communication strategies. The long-term strategy is for the indigenous churches to plant an evangelical church in each of the 58 communities in the District of Tahuania, led by well-trained pastors and ministry leaders.

- Pray for health, strength, and well-being. Dick had a knee replaced October 2023 and a shoulder replaced March 2024. The latter was a reverse-replacement that has not healed as well despite much therapy; it has re-dislocated six to eight times at intrusive moments.
- Pray for our Peruvian Asociación River-Wind team of eight, plus many volunteers under Ruth's visionary leadership. Travel and supporting logistics for the Leadership Training Center in Nueva Italia – 285 miles up the serpentine Ucayali River – is costly, time-consuming, and physically demanding.

Malcolm & Juls Clegg Navigators | Eastern Europe/Central Asia

Malcolm and Juls are based in Poland, traveling and ministering with the Navigators. They founded and coordinate a network of 16 indigenously-led, mission-oriented, interdenominational ministries called Central Eurasian Partners, working in eight countries, some of them sensitive. These partners are working in evangelism and disciple-making; youth, student, and children's work; widows and orphans; arts, education, and business; church growth; and holistic ministry. They initiate new platforms in society for ministry, Bible study groups, seminary teaching, sermons in churches, and counseling, enabling national laborers in creative outreach enterprises, aiming at spiritual transformation, social impact, and financial self-sustainability. These past few years, the Cleggs have been heavily involved in ministry to Ukraine.

- Pray for God's discernment and wisdom to know how to best serve, encourage, and support our friends and family in Christ in Ukraine, while the war and fighting continues, and afterwards. There are many physical, emotional, and practical needs that will continue as time goes by.

Equip, International | Spain

Carlos and Yolanda are church planters in Madrid. Their time is spent sharing God's love through word and deed with people they meet so that they can hear that God has a plan for them. They then help them join a church or form a group, which, in time, becomes a church where they can grow in knowledge of God.

The hope is to see more churches planted and multiplying. One special aspect of this work is coming alongside Ukrainian ministries and churches.

Tyrannus and Lydia Halls | Central Europe / South Asia

Their most literal and accurate ministry description is "to engage deeply with God and engage deeply with others." Steve regularly visits 20 ministry sites in 8 countries, with Julie joining him when she can. These ministry sites are called either a Tyrannus Hall (for men) or a Lydia Hall (for women). They are residential discipleship centers where typically 8-20 university students live together in community and are discipled during their university years. Outside of Tyrannus and Lydia Halls, Steve and Julie engage weekly or bi-weekly in deep Kingdom-focused relationships with individual elders, pastors, and missionaries as well as with couples in Christian leadership.

- Pray for spiritual growth unto Christlikeness for our 300+ university students in multi-year, residential discipleship communities (4 in Europe, 18 in Asia).
- Pray for God's sustenance, wisdom, and protection of the live-in discipler families (22 families in 9 countries).

Mariano & Fanny Pineda (Tomas, Teo)

One Collective | Galicia, Spain

Mariano and Fanny live and work on the Camino de Santiago (St. James Way), an ancient pilgrimage that each year draws hundreds of thousands of people from all over the world. Together they founded Wandering Monks, a non-profit that seeks to foster the spiritual development of all people. They focus their work in three main areas: hospitality (through Casa de Pan, a guest house right on the Camino), soul care (through one-on-one spiritual direction and group retreats), and spiritual formation (through the ministry of the written word, guiding groups on the Camino, and Godly Play[®]).

BrookLink

The mission of BrookLink is to equip global church leaders to fulfill Jesus' commission to "make disciples of all nations." BrookLink is compelled by the fact that 90% of church

leaders in Asia, Africa, and Latin America, (where the Church of Jesus Christ is growing most rapidly), are unable to afford or access biblical and theological training. BrookLink cultivates relationships with these leaders; they help catalyze discipleship initiatives that multiply, and they create customized, leave-behind resources. Their seasoned team of trainers are former and current pastors, missionaries, and seminary faculty who pour into church leaders who then pour into their flocks. BrookLink believes in starting with relationships, going where invited, listening to learn, and building coalitions of the willing. Since 2008. BrookLink has trained more than 57.000 church leaders on five continents.

- Prav for BrookLink's plan to train leaders in November 2024. Pastors from four major cities will gather for training in discipleship and disciple-making.
- Pray for BrookLink as we are in the stages of planning two simultaneous consultations on discipleship and disciple making movements in eastern and western Nepal in March 2025.
- Pray for our global partners Esavas (Africa), Dev and Cornelius (Nepal), and Phu (Far East) as we continue to collaborate with them and their networks.

Vision 5:9 Network

Vision 5:9 exists to see reproducing churches among all Muslim peoples through active engagement and effective church planting by 2025. The Vision 5:9 Network is made up of 163 organizations from 30 sending nations, led by an international steering team, all seeking to share the gospel with the Muslim world through local churches. Specifically, Elmbrook Church supports the Southeast Asia expression of this network.

Open to anyone in the community, this location provides blood pressure checks, resume and job search support, computer access and support, and assistance with medical questions and referrals. Our caring staff also provide referrals for food pantries, housing and shelters, and much more.

JAMES PLACE WASHINGTON HIGH SCHOOL

This location assists high school students with tutoring, job applications, life skills, and college prep. It is a place where students can come and be listened to and where encouragement and hope are offered as they plan for life after high school.

JAMES PLACE OBAMA SCHOOL

This location is a place of peace where students and staff can receive support and prayer. Students can also come to work on schoolwork and receive tutoring. There also are volunteers placed in classrooms to support teachers and build relationships with the students they serve.

JAMES PLACE NORTHSIDE

This location works with Partners in Hope to mentor returning citizens coming out of incarceration.

JAMES PLACE IMMIGRATION SERVICES

Serving the local immigrant and refugee community in Milwaukee, WI, highly trained accredited representatives provide consultation on immigration questions, help prepare and submit complex immigration forms, and provide a low-cost option for many who cannot afford expensive legal representation.

JAMES PLACE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH COUNSELING SERVICES


