
#### **Barnabas Group**

#### **Giving Hope This Christmas**

For the person on your list who has everything, purchase a Stocking Stuffer kit from Hope Walks: Freedom from Clubfoot!

Clubfoot is a deformity present at birth that twists the foot downward and inward, making walking difficult or impossible. Hope Walks is working in clinics in Africa and the Dominican Republic to provide treatment to correct the feet of babies who would otherwise live with crippling deformity. An important part of the correction process, the Ponseti method, is a brace and two connected shoes.

This is where your gift comes in! Purchase a kit, which includes a pair of leather and three paint pens for them to unleash their creativity for just \$20! Once they are decorated, send them back to Hope Walks (shipping label included) or return them to Otterbein UMC. Hope Walks will send the individual a photo of their completed masterpiece!
