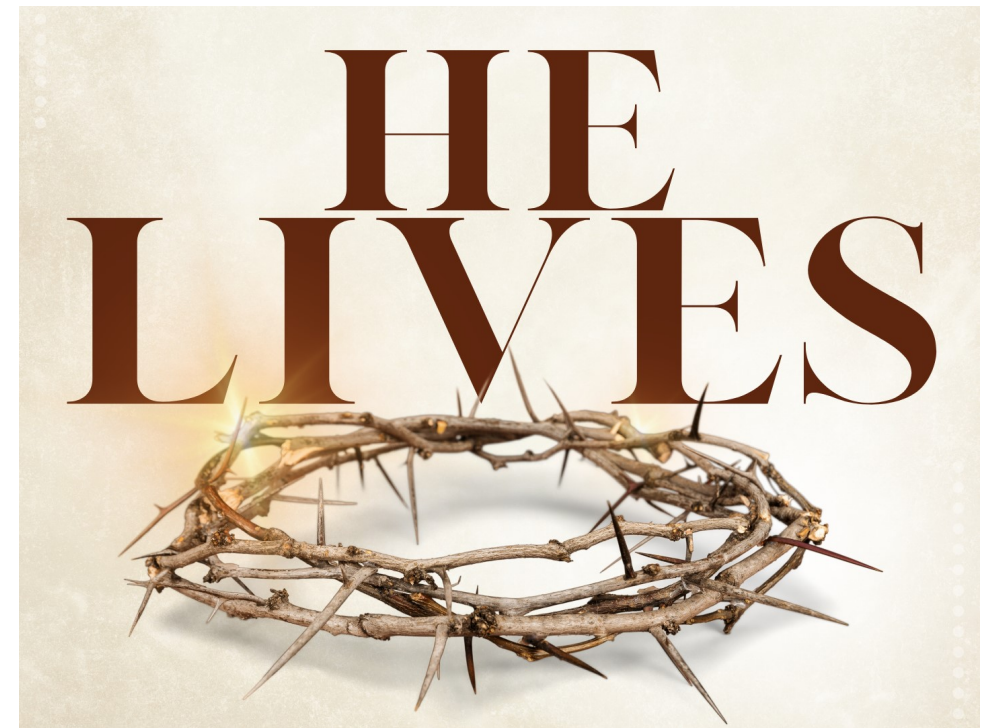

The study is **As for Me: Life Through the Lens of the Psalms** by **Adrienne Camp**.
