Examine maps, media documents, original speeches & the famous "Balfour Declaration" anew, as we study the roots of the conflict between Jews & Arabs over the modern State of Israel. These 10 sessions encompass the return of the Jews to the land, the role of the British, the Cold War, the rise of Palestinian nationalism, the 1967 War, and the post-1967 vision for a "Greater Israel", including the initial rise of Islamic fundamentalism. From religion and culture to history, politics, economics, identity, and survival, the material is designed to encourage discussion and debate, challenging learners to appreciate the basis of the claims made by all sides.

Feminine Phenomena in the Bible

In addition to less-often studied commentary on the spiritual giantesses of the Bible, we will explore intriguingly feminine - and not necessarily feminist - phenomena in unexpected passages. Text, image, and sound will illuminate ancient mores that persist to this day, as well as related dynamics around identity, gender, and values. Texts will be assessed through mythical, historical, theological, geopolitical, and sociological lenses - considering ethics, current affairs, and pop culture - to discover new and relevant ideas and to co-create interpretations (midrashim). A Sephardic rabbi and philosopher who became one of the most prolific and influential Torah scholars of the Middle ages, he was also a preeminent astronomer and physician serving as the personal physician of Saladin.
