"Thriving in the Kingdom Through Prayer"

Who is ready to thrive today? Psalms 92:12-15 - The Righteous shall flourish like the palm tree (1): he shall grow like a cedar (2) in Lebanon. 13 Those that be planted in the house of the LORD (3) shall flourish in the courts of our God. 14 They shall still bring forth fruit in old age (4); they shall be fat and flourishing (5); 15 To shew that the LORD is upright (6): he is my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in him.

6 times we see how we can Thrive. To hold on these 6 truths, we have to be a person of prayer. Prayer is the glove that fits the hand of success, and the sandal that fits the foot of dominion.

Prayer is the key to all victory. Without it you will never grasp it or walk in dominion from it.

Matthew 6:33 - But seek ye first the kingdom (dominion) of God, and his righteousness (doctrine, integrity, purity of life); and all these things shall be added unto you. (food, drink, clothing, basic needs, worries of tomorrow)

Thriving in the Kingdom of God is not about material success—it's about **divine alignment**, **spiritual power**, and **kingdom fruitfulness**. And the **gateway to thriving is prayer**. Prayer is not a ritual—it's a relationship, and it's the very lifeline of kingdom living.

Point 1: Prayer is the Key to Seeking the Kingdom

Matthew 6:33

- To thrive, we must **seek God first**—and we do this by **prioritizing prayer.**
- Everything you need—direction, provision, peace—is added when you seek God.
 - Prayer reorders your life under heaven's authority.

ALM: If you're not seeking, you're not thriving.

Point 2: Prayer is Your Power Supply

Luke 18:1 – "Men ought always to pray, and not to faint."

- A prayerless believer is a powerless believer.
- Without prayer, you faint spiritually, emotionally, and mentally.
- Thriving requires **daily spiritual strength** that comes from time in God's presence.

ALM: Prayer fuels your inner strength to overcome storms and setbacks.

Point 3: Prayer Brings God's Peace

Philippians 4:6-7 - Be careful for nothing; but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. 7 And the peace of God, which passed all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

- Worry chokes your growth—prayer replaces worry with worship.
- When you bring everything to God in prayer, **peace** becomes your foundation.

• You can't thrive in chaos—but you can flourish in God's peace.

ALM: Peace is not the absence of problems—it's the presence of God through prayer.

Point 4: Prayer Releases Supernatural Results

James 5:16 – "The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availed much."

- Your prayers **carry authority** when you're aligned with God.
- **Breakthroughs, healing, restoration** all flow through prayer.
- Don't underestimate the power of your own mouth when you're praying in righteousness.

ALM: Prayer doesn't just talk to God—it activates heaven on earth.

Point 5: Prayer Is a Lifestyle, Not an Event

1 Thessalonians 5:17 – "Pray without ceasing."

- Thriving believers develop a **lifestyle of communion** with God.
- It's not just about "prayer time," it's about living prayerfully—walking with God daily.
 - Prayer invites God into every part of your day.

ALM: A consistent prayer life leads to consistent kingdom results.

Point 6: Prayer Unlocks Divine Insight

Jeremiah 33:3 – "Call unto me, and I will answer thee..."

- Prayer opens you to wisdom, revelation, and divine strategies.
- If you're not hearing from God, you're living by human understanding.
- You thrive when you pray and God shows you what you didn't even know to ask.

ALM: Prayer gives you an advantage the world can't explain.

Conclusion:

If you want to **thrive in the Kingdom**, then you must commit to a life of prayer. Not just praying when you're in trouble, but **living in communication with God daily**.
