### Summoned to Serve

Covenant, Acts 13:1–13, offers believers a powerful example of what it means to be summoned by God. The church at Antioch was summoned by God for His work. The passage begins with a group of faithful leaders worshiping and fasting before the Lord when the Holy Spirit began to speak to them. Barnabas and Saul were summoned to be set apart for God's work. Barnabas and Saul did not appoint themselves, nor were they sent because of popularity or preference. Like Barnabas and Saul, we too are summoned to embrace the clarion call, not for personal ambition, but to expand the Kingdom of God armed with the Word of God. When we understand that we are called by Him, our service gains purpose, direction, and humility because we know the work belongs to the Lord and not to us.

Today, the church must continue this pattern by recognizing gifts, affirming callings, and sending believers into the work of the gospel. When the church takes commissioning seriously, ministry becomes unified, purposeful, and empowered by prayer rather than driven by individual effort. Covenant Community Church recognizes the shared responsibility of evangelizing the lost. Every believer is called by God to utilize their God-given gift for the purpose of Kingdom expansion. Every believer is commissioned by God to remain unified in faith, stand in authority and power, and support the work for which we have been called as the Body of Christ. Every believer should be committed to the work even when the work seems difficult, the results are uncertain, and the path is uncomfortable.

As a called-out body of believers, you will be opposed, resisted, and challenged, but stay focused on the work ahead. During this season of turmoil and uncertainty, embrace God's summons, lean on God, and trust Him to carry you through. When believers are called by God, commissioned by the church, and committed in heart the gospel moves forward, lives are changed, and the work of Christ continues from generation to generation.
