21 Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God.



Principles from Ephesians 5:15-21

- Spirituality requires alertness to dangers and opportunities.(5:15)
- God wants us to make the most of the time that He gives us.(5:16)
- Christians apply God's will to their experience as the standard of understanding and rule of conduct.(5:17)
- There is a limited comparison between being under the control of a substance and under the control of the Spirit.(5:18)

Principles from Ephesians 5:15-21

- God puts Spirit-filled believers under a higher instrumentality for His working.(5:18b)
- Worship is a manifestation of being filled with the Spirit.(5:19)
- The believer is to minister to the Lord with the heart.(5:19b)
- Gratitude is recognition of what God has done for us in Christ without our merit. (5:20)
- The motive for giving deference to other Christians is our Lord. (5:21)

2. The Wise Seek the Lord's Will

Ephesians 5

17.Therefore, do not be **foolish**, but understand what the Lord's will is.

Apply God's will as the standard of understanding & rule of conduct.(5:17)

*The Spirit brings discipline not reckless (out of control) behavior.



Disruptions Can Make You Lose Your Mind

What intoxicating agents most often disrupt your discipline and cause you to act recklessly?

- **Alcohol**: Substances that reduce your inhibitions
- Impatience: Agitated by apathy, slow progress, loss, or setbacks
- **Pride**: Agitation that comes with being overlooked or disrespected
- **Toxicity**: Agitation that comes with people failing to live up to your expectations
- **Unforgiveness:** Agitation that comes with people who have offended you
