Thank you for joining us for Children's Sabbath today!

At Highland, our Ministry with Children and Their Families strives to create a sacred space where families with children have opportunities to experience God's love and encounter the stories of Jesus that form and transform, while participating in the creation of a world where love and justice abound. We also work to provide parents with tools to nurture the faith lives of their children, as well as their own. Our deep hope is that families are actively exploring together what it means to be faithful followers of Christ in their daily lives.

We do this through **Bible study classes** on Sunday mornings, where children encounter and explore the stories of Jesus. We do this through **children's choirs** on Wednesday evenings (during the school year), the joyful discovery of God's transforming LOVE through music. We do this through **summer camps** that allow children to explore their faith in community, developing the muscles that help us discover, grow, and serve together. We do this through **fellowship**, like preschool playdates and picnics and egg hunts and festivals.

And it is only possible with the leadership of **nearly 100 volunteers each month!** At present, there are 13 teachers of Bible study classes, 17 children's choir teachers, 61worship care volunteers, and a handful of children's worship volunteers who make our ministry come to life. Our Families with Children Ministry Group also assists in planning for special events.
