### WHAT IS FBC'S PURPOSE?

"The purpose of Family Bible Church is to glorify God by the edifying of the body to Christ-like character and evangelize to Oak Harbor and the surrounding community through the saints; as well as to reach out to the unsaved in the world through mis-



sions and to provide a center for Christian fellowship and the worship of Almighty God."

This purpose statement was written 50 years ago by the founders of Family Bible Church and is still as valid today as it was in the 1970's. In fact, it is part of our Constitution.

### Notice the parts:

**Edify the Body** – "to instruct and improve the saints especially in moral and religious knowledge". This ties directly to our Mission Statement, "To Make Maturing Disciples", which is our inward focus.

**Evangelize our community** – Again, tying directly to our Mission Statement, "To Make Disciples", which is our outward focus. Our Community Outreach Group is an important part of this effort, meeting physical needs in the community.

Reach out to the world through Missions (global partners) – Our Global Partners remain a key part of who we are. We are dedicated to maximum financial support of our worldwide GP's and honoring them as well as letting our body meet some of them through our Global Partners Conference each year.

**Fellowship** – This is what makes us a family, the opportunity to gather together, love and support each other, and grow in our relationship with Jesus Christ together.

**Worship** – Our corporate acknowledgement and celebration of God's power and perfection in gratitude and submission to Him.
