Missions

Shibu Oommen and his wife, Mary, are serving with Evangelism Explosion International (EE).

Shibu recently led a fruitful Share Your Faith workshop at a Presbyterian church in Mexico City. Forty-three people attended and afterwards went out to share the gospel in their community. This was an ice-breaking event for the church, and they are planning a weekly evangelism outreach to their neighborhood.

Now that school is back in session, Shibu and others have continued their outreach at Millersville and Kutztown Universities. They have had many interesting conversations with students there, where seeds were planted and some professions of faith were made.

Shibu also continues his Share Your Faith workshops at local churches and has completed a second level of training at a church in Lancaster, where five people are now qualified to be EE trainers. Please pray for the following:
