

Missions

Michael Goodlin serves with Reformed University Fellowship (RUF) as Lehigh University's campus minister. Michael reports that almost seventy students came on their annual ski trip. It was an amazing opportunity for non-Christians to be involved in the life of RUF. Michael's chairlift partner began the ride by asking, "So what is it like being the campus minister for RUF?" This led to a conversation on what it means to be Christian, the uniqueness of Christianity compared to all other belief systems and Jesus' call to relationship through repentance and faith. At the end of the ride the student said, "The more I study physics the more I am convinced that there is a God. Could we meet up some time to talk more?" This type of conversation was not unique to Michael as others reported similar experiences while riding to the top of the mountain. Michael asks us to pray for the following:

- -that RUF members would have boldness to clearly make known the truth of the gospel so that these non-Christian students would come to faith
- -that those students who have just come to faith would grow in maturity, knowledge, faith, and holiness
- -that the Lord would clarify who He is raising up to be executive team members, Bible study leaders, musicians, and other members of the ministry team
- -that students would be convicted of the value of summer camp, that funding would be provided for scholarships, and that the Lord would give the camp speaker wisdom and joy in preparing his sermons
