Flavien and Inyange are missionaries stationed in the US serving churches and church planters in sensitive countries. Flavien was invited to contribute a chapter in a book introducing Covenant Theology to today's French speaking world. It is an honor and joy for him to do this, but also a challenge as he has not composed anything of that kind in French before. Please pray for this endeavor and for two chapters in another book that are past due.

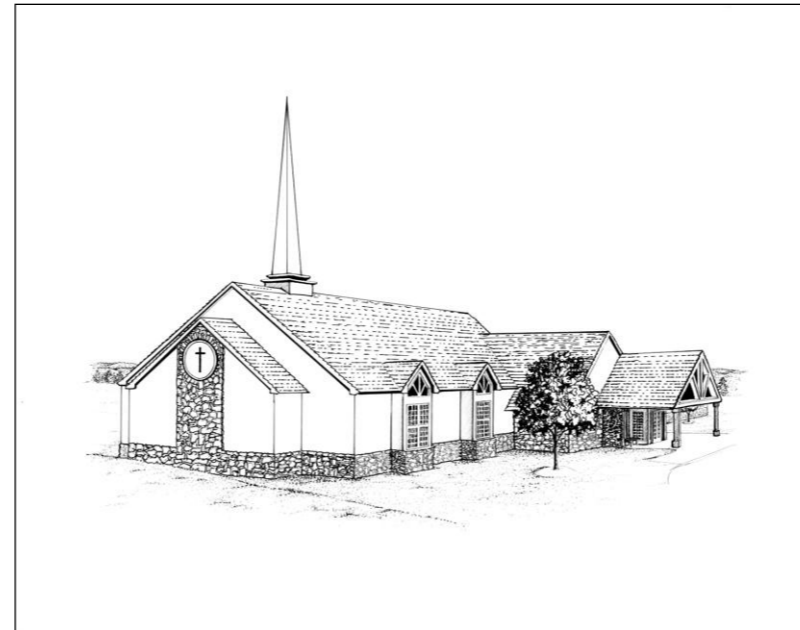
While he does not know when he will be able to travel overseas, Flavien is preparing for a few commitments. First, he is preparing about five hours of instruction on the Westminster Standards for a Reformed seminary in Quebec called the Farel Institute. Second, he is working on two courses on hermeneutics and missiology for pastors located on an island off the mainland of Asia where government-run persecution is quite severe. Finally, building on the experience of the seminar that he gave in Senegal, he is also working on a course in agroecology from a biblical perspective in French. Please pray that these courses will be used by the Lord to build His church worldwide. In family news, Inyange continues to struggle with some chronic health issues but has seen some improvement in energy. Flavien did obtain his early work authorization card and driver's license but is still waiting on his visa.

Please pray for Inyange's endurance, health and morale.
